Prizes will follow the [Hort System](#). The winners of the 6 major prizes cant win the ratingprices.

Ratingprices: 2000 – 2199: **2000 nok**, 0 – 1999: **2000 nok**. One player can only compete for the ratingprice in his own rating group. The tournament will be included in the Grand Prix summary.

Players are allowed to have two byes = 0,5 points in the first 5 rounds, this must be agreed in writing before the tournament starts.

HCI u2000 – 90 min + 30 sec increment per move from move 1.

Moneyprices: 30% - 25% - 20% - 15% - 5% - 5%

Prizes will follow the Hort System. Moneyprizes are calculated as a percentage of total prize pool that is at least 50% of the participant fee. The tournament will be included in the Grand Prix summary. Players are allowed to have three byes = 0,5 points in the first 8 rounds, this must be agreed in writing before the tournament starts.
